Join us for the 2nd Annual Montana Ride to Remember on August 15

The 2015 Montana Ride to Remember will occur on Saturday, August 15th. We welcome anyone to join us. The ride is hosted by the Montana POW/MIA Awareness Association in recognition of and to bring awareness to POW/MIA related issues.

WHAT: The Montana Ride to Remember will follow Highway 287 from Helena to West Yellowstone. This is Montana's POW/MIA Memorial Highway. The majority of riders are on motorcycles, cars are welcome at the back of the pack.

WHEN: The third Saturday in August. August 15, 2015. 9:30a.m. Memorial Service and 10:15a.m. Ride Starts. Arrival in West Yellowstone, approximately 4:00p.m.

WHERE: The ride begins at Memorial Park, 1203 Last Chance Gulch, Helena.

BBQ & Fundraiser will be held on Friday night, August 14 at 6:00p.m. to 9:00p.m. Food, music, raffle for prizes and 50/50 winnings.

Special Commemorative Event: The riders will roll loudly through Three Forks at approximately noon, to pay tribute to Col. Dean Andrew Pogreba, USAF who was declared missing 50 years ago while serving in Vietnam.

The 183 mile ride from Helena to West Yellowstone is free to anyone that is interested in participating. There will be an opening and closing ceremony for the ride where proper recognition is given to each of the 55 Montana POW/MIA personnel. We also ride to keep the memory alive for over 83,000 American personnel declared POW/MIA while serving their country.

While we will sell patches and t-shirts, they are not a requirement to participate. All funds raised, after expenses for the ride are covered, will go directly to support maintenance and replacement of the POW/MIA flags that we post along Highway 287 in Helena. The flags fly along the POW/MIA Memorial Highway on all days that hold military significance. The Montana POW/MIA Awareness Association is a 501(c)(3).
